Course Objectives	The aim of the course is to raise awareness on the evolution of European policies and their implications for Turkey by explaining basic concepts and transferring knowledge on European Union (EU)
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Course Content	Throughout the semestre, after explaining the fundamentals of the European Union as to the Treaties, integration process, institutions and decision making process, relations of Turkey with the EU is analyzed with reference to basic documents, phases and instutuions of Association Agreement. Contemporary developments such as Lisbon Strategy, Regulatory Impact Assessment, European Constitution, Accession Talks with Turkey are dealt in detail. Beginning with the 8th week, students are oriented towards workshops and the papers developed throughout the workshops are discussed in the class.
